Appendix A

Current School Grading categorizes schools into 'A' to 'F' grades using a total of 600 possible points. Schools with a grade of 'A' are the highest performing schools, while schools with a grade of 'F' are the lowest performing schools. The participation rates and adequate progress of the lowest groups are also taken into account when assigning school grades. The table below shows the total points and the criteria corresponding to school grades.

School Grade	Points	Other Criteria
A	410 or higher	met 2 years for the lowest groups and at least 95% tested
B	380 or higher	met 2 years for the lowest groups and at least 90% tested
C	320 or higher	met 2 years for the lowest groups and at least 90% tested
D	280 or higher	at least 90% tested
F	less than 280	or less than 90% tested

The 600 total points include 300 points for achieving level 3 or higher, 200 points for annual learning gains, and 100 points for improving the lowest scoring students.

Changes in FY05 impacted 400 of the 600 total points:

- a. FCAT writing scores (100 points) increased to 3.5 for proficiency.
- b. Annual learning gains (200 points) for the first time counted all students, including ESE and ESOL students with gain scores.
- c. Similarly, the gain scores for all the lowest scoring students (100 points), including ESE and ESOL students counted in the school grade calculations.
- d. As in the previous years, only standard-curriculum students¹ are included in the points for achieving level 3 or higher in reading and math as well as 3.5 or higher for writing.

¹All ESE students are currently excluded except gifted, hospital-homebound, and speech. All LEP students less than two years are currently excluded. Only students enrolled in Survey 2 (October) and Survey 3 (February) are included.
