What is PBS?

- Positive Behavior Support (PBS) is a new way to think about behavior. PBS is an effective way of looking at behavior to decrease negative behavior and increase positive behavior. Thus, creating a positive environment for students to learn.
- Understanding the function of behavior helps the PBS team and teachers positively enforce the positive and decrease the negative behavior a student may exhibit.

What is PBS?

- PBS uses research based strategies to re-teach expectations and positive behavior.

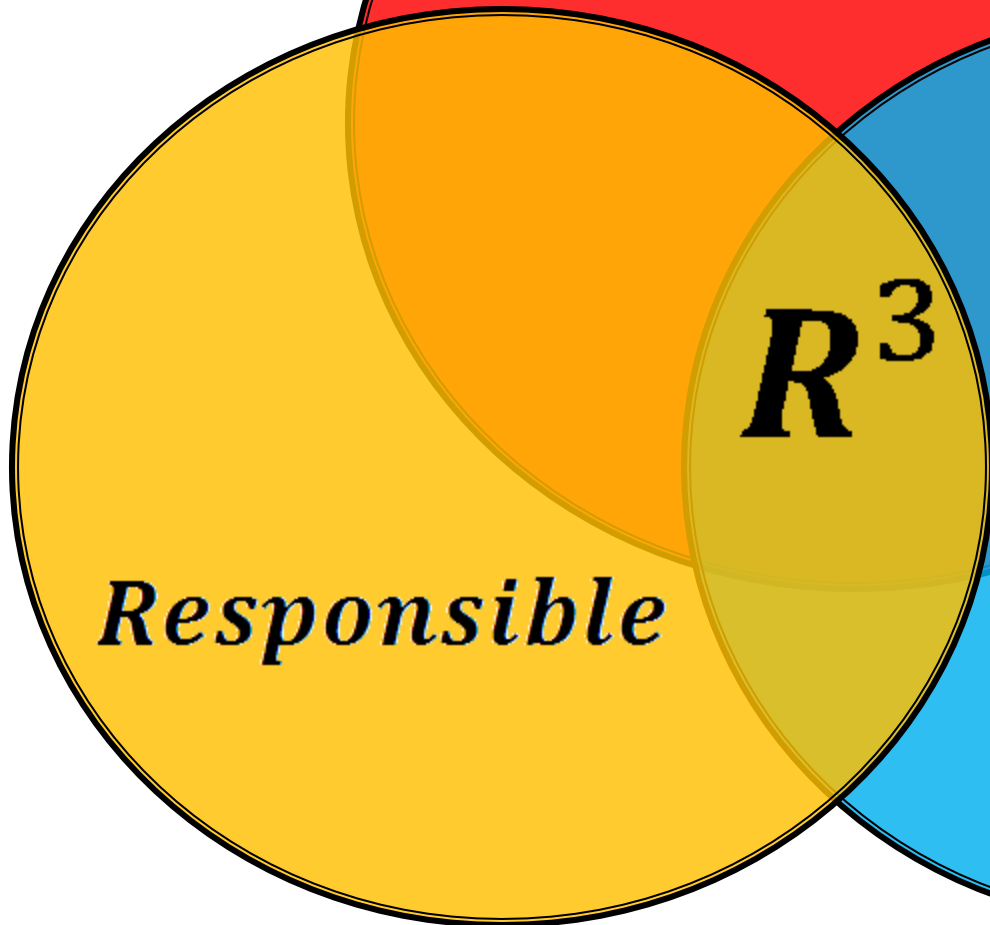

CMS School-Wide Incentives

- Hawk Dollars:
A student earns hawk dollars when a staff member notices the student following the school's expectations.
- The student may use these Hawk dollars to purchase items at the PBS school store or any other school-wide incentive.

Positive Referrals

- This is an incentive to encourage students to follow school wide expectations. If a student receives a positive referral from a staff member they receive a free Applebee's entrée and other prizes.

Renaissance Cards

- Every nine weeks students with specific point average (GPA) earn different level cards. These cards allow students to receive discounts from area merchants. The following are the different level cards
 - Platinum 4.0
 - Gold 3.8-3.9
 - Silver 3.5-3.79
 - Bronze 3.0-3.49

Hawk Squawks

- A staff member contacts parents by email, telephone or through a note with positive news about your child.
