

EES UNIFORM POLICY-UPDATED for 2011-2012

Dear Parents,

At the May 31, 2011 meeting of the EES School Advisory Council, the members unanimously voted to alter the EES Uniform Dress Code for students. The basic change to the policy is that students may now wear collared polo style shirts in **any solid color**. This change goes into effect for the 2011-2012 school year. Please see the updated uniform dress code below with updates in red:

ATTIRE

The School Advisory Council have adopted a Uniform Dress Code for students. The 2011-2012 EES uniform will consist of the following:

- Navy blue or khaki slacks, shorts, skorts or jumpers (jeans are not acceptable). Belts are strongly encouraged.
- Collared polo style shirts in any solid color (no decorations, designs or insignias- small brand name logos are acceptable.) Short or long sleeved shirts are appropriate. Shirts must fall 3 inches below the waist band or be tucked in. Undershirts should be white or match the color of the polo shirt. Undershirts must be tucked in.
- Closed toe/heel shoes; tennis shoes are strongly encouraged
- Hair shall be cleaned and neatly groomed.
- Hats or caps shall not be worn in the school building except for approved areas identified by the principal.
- Adornment which is attached (pierced) to exposed body parts other than the ears are not acceptable.
- Shoes with wheels are not allowed. (Heelys)
