Before your child(ren) can begin the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, he/she must have documentation of having received the following immunizations:

- Tdap booster (Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis) (after the age of 7)

### IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2011-2012 GRADE 7

- 5 DTP/DTaP- Diphtheria – Tetanus – Pertussis
- 4 Polio
- 2 MMR- Measles – Mumps – Rubella
- 3 Hepatitis B (Hep B)
- 1 Chickenpox - Varicella
- 1 Tdap- Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis booster

We encourage all parents to have your child(ren) seen by a private physician or health care provider in the community prior to the busy summer season to receive the required immunizations. Private physicians and clinics charge according to their established fees.

Vaccines required for children are available free of charge from all Collier County Health Department facilities. Remember, you must bring your child's immunization records with you to help determine what immunizations are required and to provide the information necessary to fill out the Florida Certificate of Immunization Form DH 680.
