The District is approaching the end of Phase One of the strategic planning process. The purpose of Phase One is for the school board and district leadership to identify and clarify overall goals and key priorities through a process that is rooted in Connect Now. Phase Two will involve the convening of operational teams that include community members to build the action plans to support the strategic priorities in Phase One.

The Education Foundation's role is to conduct community-based sessions and teacher sessions throughout the course of the process and to ensure the collective voice of the community through Connect Now is integral to the process. As the plans are drafted in Phase Two, there will be sessions to get input throughout the process—we encourage you to participate in those sessions.

The Education Foundation, in collaboration with others, has been working create opportunities to learn and to continue to share opportunities through Connect Now. We continue community outreach with opportunities for the Superintendent to share a school update and have discussion about complex issues in smaller forums which provide more flexibility for discussion and building understanding of important topics for education in our community.
